Resolution Title: *Laulima Training*

BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT SENATE:

WHEREAS, the Associated Students of the University of Hawai'i – West O'ahu (ASUHW) Senate is the elected body representing approximately 3,000 classified undergraduate students; and

WHEREAS, stated in the constitution of the Associated Students of the University of Hawai'i – West O'ahu "The purpose of this organization shall be to provide democratic representation for the students of the University of Hawai'i – West O'ahu and to promote student participation in educational, cultural, social and community activities;" and

WHEREAS, each UH student has an account on Laulima (a learning and collaboration server) provided by the University of Hawai'i System where they can log on to get information about their classes; and

WHEREAS, University instructors are provided this service to provide information to their students; and

WHEREAS, they have access to their instructors, peers, and university services through Laulima; and

WHEREAS, Laulima could be used as a place where students and instructors could use as a place to meet and if needed, a hub where students can get to secondary websites that are used in their classes; and

WHEREAS, Laulima support for students and instructors are available 24 hours a day, for seven days a week for 365 days; and

WHEREAS, resources are available for faculty and students to familiarize themselves with Laulima; and

BE IT RESOLVED, that the ASUHWO Senate will work together with the university staff through the Office of Distance Learning and/or Office of Professional Development and Academic Support to provide training for instructors to learn how to effectively use Lulima; and

BE IT RESOLVED, that the ASUHWO Senate will enact this resolution by urging the Faculty Senate to support this resolution by urging instructors to receive Lulima training; and

BE IT RESOLVED, that the ASUHWO Senate with the support of Academic Affairs to support this resolution by urging the use of this service; and

BE IT RESOLVED from the date of passing this resolution; instructors' training on the features and uses of Lulima will be implemented by the appropriate parties to deliver said training and be given at the beginning of each semester or following; and
