Act Title: To Appropriate Funding for Hale Kuahuokala gifts

BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT SENATE:

SECTION 1: PURPOSE

The Associated Students of the University of Hawai'i – West O'ahu (ASUHW O) was chartered by the Board of Regents to act as the student government representing all classified undergraduate students. The purpose of this bill is to provide funding for the gifting of wooden benches and lauhala mats to newly built Hale Kuahuokala. If possible, an inscription shall be made upon the benches indicating the sponsorship of ASUHW O. The benches and lauhala mats will allow students a comfortable place to sit while attending classes, lectures, and community events in Hale Kuahuokala. They will be a gift from our Senate to the students who use them, in hopes of fostering a positive remembrance of the spirit of giving which we proactively embrace.

SECTION 2: APPROPRIATIONS

A total of up to \$1,000.00 shall be appropriated from Senate Budget (Program Supplies.)	
Benches.....	\$1,000.00
Lauhala mats.....	\$150.00
Total.....	\$1,150.00

SECTION 3: PROVISIONS

The ASUHW O shall be recognized as full sponsor of the bill.

SECTION 4: The Treasurer is authorized to handle the monies appropriated.

SECTION 5: This act shall take effect upon approval of the Senate.
