Bill Title: Appropriate Funding To Support Aloha 'Āina

BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNDERGRADUATE SENATE:

1. SECTION 1: PURPOSE

2. The Associated Students of the University of Hawai'i – West Oahu was chartered by The
3. Board of Regents to act as the student government representing all classified undergraduate
4. students. The purpose of this bill is for the Aloha 'Āina club to foster food independence
5. and sustainability within the community by educating our students and community members
6. as we offer a positive cultural learning space for everyone to thrive in. This bill will also
7. instill faith in the students of their ASUHWU student government members, making the
8. students feel like they are being supported in their academic experiences and goals during
9. their time at UHWO. This bill is to request for funds for the Aloha 'Āina club so that
10. students may continue to foster their cultural leadership and practice through the projects
11. within the club. Currently Aloha Aina is in need of materials and equipment to continue
12. their sustainable efforts that align with the UHWO campus goals.
