BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNDERGRADUATE SENATE:

1 SECTION 1: PURPOSE

3 The Associated Students of the University of Hawai'i- West O'ahu was chartered
4 by the Board of Regents to act as the student government representing all
5 classified undergraduate students. The purpose of this bill is to provide funding
