Act Title: To Appropriate Funding for UHWO West Fest Earth Day
In the Senate February 17, 2015

BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNDERGRADUATE SENATE:

SECTION 1: PURPOSE

The Associated Students of the University of Hawai'i - West O'ahu (ASUHOWO) is chartered by the Board of Regents to act as the student government representing all classified undergraduate students. The purpose of this bill is to provide funding for additional activities for the West Fest/Earth Day event to be held at the University of Hawai'i - West O'ahu hosted by ASUHOWO. Students and their guests who participate will have to sign a waiver and provide UHWO ID or Hawaii State issued Identification. It will reflect well on our Senate as well as on our entire student body by increasing student participation and encouraging community involvement.

SECTION 2: APPROPRIATIONS

A total of up to \$4,000 shall be appropriated from the Senate.
